“Instilling Democracy in Law Enforcement in Foreign Countries”

Mr. Wheeler is a consultant that travels to other countries to help them develop democratic law enforcement. He has done 5 tours each lasting 1 year each.

He has been to Kosovo, Macedonia, Jordan, Bangladesh and Iraq.

While in Kosovo he was training Albanian and Serbians which hate each other just because of who they are.

Mr. Wheeler is there to help bridge the gap by teaching democracy to the police. Also they are trying to help with human rights by teaching the rule of law. After Kosovo he went to Macedonia where he was teaching

police to learn a traffic management program. In Macedonia the highway is anarchy because they don't enforce the laws.

He then went to Jordan to train Iraqi recruits. Mr. Wheeler was training Palestine's for security forces. He was in Iraq from 2006-2007 at a police college. Training recruits and police with TIP (Transitional Integration Program). Where there was a young boy of 13 years old who tried to come to training twice even though he was too young to train.

He was there to design a curriculum for Iraqi police where 3 weeks was just in officer safety for survival. In Iraq women were finally allowed to vote for the first time in January 2004 where they came out in full force. The military and police had to provide security for all the people that voted in that election. Mr. Wheeler has also been to Bangladesh but he was there for a different reason than he has been to for the other countries because when he was not there he was not there post conflict like all the other places. The main idea to all this is that people want democracy not government dictatorship.
