## Hi-Speed Road Rallies – Corvette Style by Craig Homchick

Craig Homchick has a CPA firm and is a Wenatchee native. Went to WSU and graduated from Cornell. His hobby is the Road Rallying in his corvette. He wanted to make sure since Tom Robbins and Karen Dewitt were present that they knew that no traffic laws were broken. Road Rallying is all about the excuse to drive fast without getting pulled over. This event was started by Roger Ward who won 2 Indy 500's in '69 and '72. Where Craig has participated is in Las Vegas where they close the highway so that people can drive fast. There are lots of different style cars some are even created in different ways with homemade stuff. One corvette had a parachute on the back. Not all the cars are corvettes ranging from GTO's, Porsches, Ford pickups and Corvairs. The Ford pickup is a 1937 and does 180 mph, the Corvair does 180 mph as well.

With the race there are also lots of other things to do at the event. There is a car show, vendors and lots of racer participation. The race is 9 miles long and you have to pick the speed in which you want your car to race. You have to have your tires inspected to make sure they are able to sustain the event. You also have to have a 5 point belt, a roll bar and a helmet. When the event starts you line up and wait your turn and the line can be 4 miles from the start. Usually about 150-200 cars in the event and you go out in order. The wait can be anywhere from 1 to 4 hours before you actually start. They have a spotter plane, 300 course workers and an air ambulance since not all cars go out ok throughout the race. Minimum speed is 90 mph and each car goes out a minute apart. When picking your target speed you try to get there and can only go 30 mph under your target speed. The highway is mostly straight but it does have some curves through a canyon and the speed limit is normally 55 mph

meaning the rule of thumb is to double that amount. There are some obstacles that come into play once they had some horses close by that they had to wait for them to be moved off, there is a cattle guard on the road. At the end of the race they have an awards banquet where you can receive your plastic trophy based on you close to target speed. Craig finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at 150 mph out of 26. Craig's car is stock except for the cooling system that he had installed so that he can go at those speeds. It costs \$500 to enter the event. It was asked if you got pulled over at the speed of 180 mph what would happen and it was stated that you could get 1 year in jail, \$500 fine and your car impounded. It was an entertaining program thank you very much to Craig Homchick.

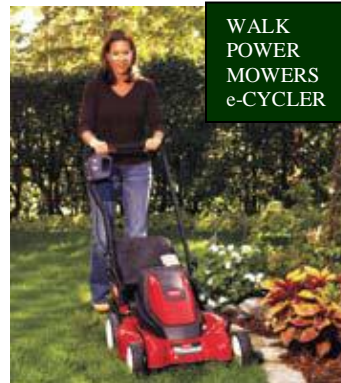
