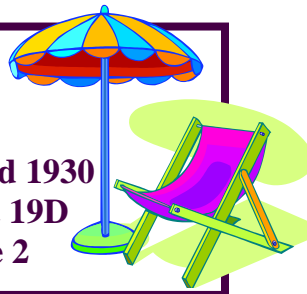

Youth United by Trina Heuchert



Youth United is a student volunteer program created by the United Way.

The youth united program was originally started in Pierce County and then copied by the Chelan/Douglas County United Way.

Last year was the first year of the program and had a great success for the first year with 122 students signing up. Out of the 122 students 20 of them received there varsity letter for volunteer hours in the community.

The students are required to perform 145 hours of service, maintain a 2.0 grade point average and have similar requirements that you would need to be involved in school sports. The volunteer year is from April 1st to March 31st.

The first year included 4 school districts who wanted to be involved in the program. They were Cashmere, Waterville, Wenatchee and East Wenatchee and were for grades 9-12. This year they have added a new school district being Leavenworth and have also included

the middle schools as well. Already to date they have 200 kids signed up for the 2011-2012 school year. In the hopes of getting even more of them to finish the requirements to receive their varsity letter.

They are hoping that by getting kids involved in volunteering that they will discover and develop skills, gain academic knowledge through services and learning activities and to also receive recognition for the effort that they are putting forth.

This is a great opportunity for students to get out in the community and learn what happens in the community and to meet the people that also participate in volunteering as adults with the satisfaction of doing something for someone else.

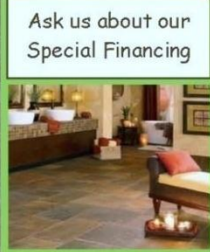
