He started volunteering in June of 2010. He works with various churches to raise awareness and develop local programs. Medical International was created in 1979 and is still going strong. They have over 2,000 volunteer teams since 1979.

This year they have had over 2.5 million people who have helped in 52 nations they range from dentists, doctors, nurses and any other volunteers that are willing to donate their time. Also, last year they sent \$189 million in supplies that were shipped to 47 countries.

Along with help out other countries they provide dental buses in Washington, Oregon and Montana to low income people that cannot afford to go to a dentist. They have 12 buses that travel around providing the service. The

dental buses have been around since 1989 where they have seen 176,000 patients. It was a wonderful program and if you would like to learn more about them you can go to www.medicalteams.org.

As for the luncheon itself it was a huge success. This year was the largest crowd that the luncheon has ever had. They also awarded Dr. Gene Kupferman Apple Citizen of the Year, and Dr. William Steward & Wilfred Woods were made the Grand Marshals. Thanks for all who participated.
