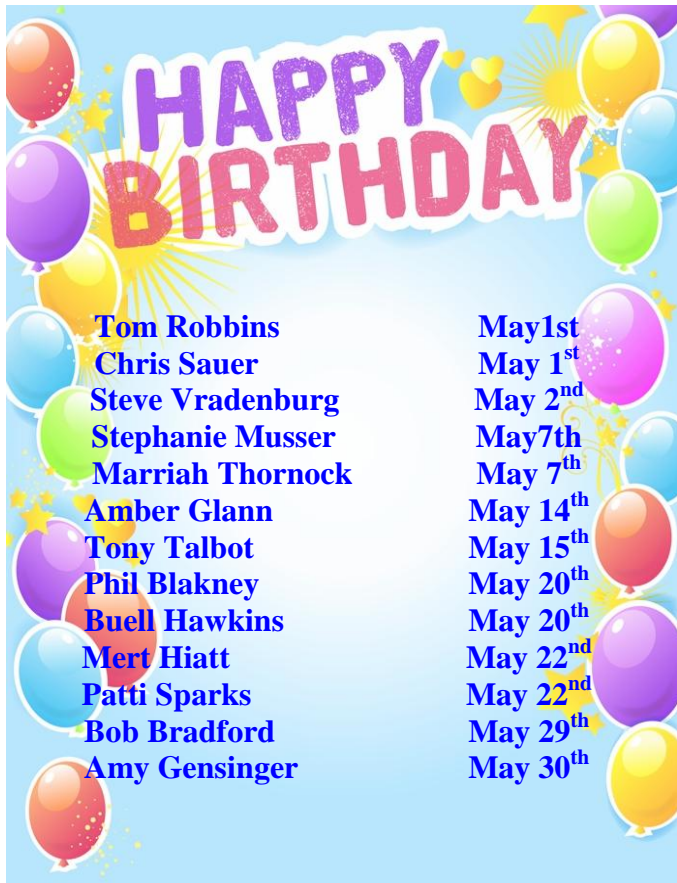

Westside High School Tom McNair and Gill Sparks

Westside High School was started in 1987 and has grown ever since and they are now celebrating 25 years. Downtown Rotary was looking for a project and they have taken on creating a different perception for Westside High School and to also help raise extra funding to keep them going.

Since WSHS started over 1500 students have graduated, they are fully accredited, they are 80% proficient in courses to pass, alumni are successful in the real world, parents are happy and encouraged that their child can get an education, long term facility that believe that "all students can succeed" and the students feel accepted, gain hope and confidence and to feel worthy.

WSHS lets you receive an education and a diploma. It is not a GED it is a real diploma. The program is to help kids fit in where they

can't fit in in a regular school environment. It helps them by letting they go at their own pace and still get the help that they need. The students are held accountable for themselves and their work. It is a privilege to be there and they know it because if they don't keep on track they can be removed from the school and someone else gets the spot. WSHS has a waiting list for entry into the school. That should show it is working. Rotary is starting a public campaign to help raise awareness of the need and what is accomplished at WSHS. They want to raise visibility, contribute money and mentoring, recognize and appreciate that WSHS has made NCW communities a better place to live by "Changing Minds, Changing Lives one at a time." They have looked at some of the statistics and have found that out of the 9 Eastern Washington Districts similar in size and have found that Westside High School is second in reading, fourth in math, fifth in writing and of the

graduates rate first in science.

Rotary wants everyone to become involved in helping raise the awareness and to also help in raising money for WSHS. They are using their raffle ticket sales to help raise money for WSHS plus they are going around the community with their presentation.
