Scott also thanked our group for the work we do for them at the games and also in all that we do in the community.

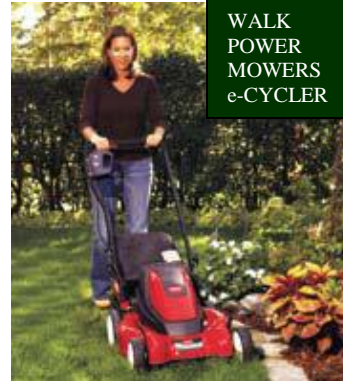
