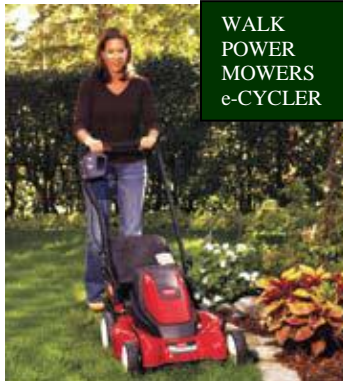

Senior Activity Center Lori Kostor

Lori has been with the Senior Center for 4 years and has been the executive director for 3 ½ years. She used to work at the Aging and Adult care at CWH before coming to the Senior Center. She cares a lot about her job and what she is doing for these seniors she is very passionate about this organization. Unlike some senior centers throughout the state the Wenatchee Valley is a nonprofit organization and does not rely on the city budget. They raise their funding through their

thrift shop that raised over \$150,000 last year alone. They also raise money from their Christmas craft bazaar that they have in November and last year it raised between \$8,000 and \$10,000. They have bingo every week, raffles, dues, and the corporate sponsor program along with other activities and events that help to keep their facility running. Currently they have 1800 members and then they have about 2,000 to 3,000 that come thru the door in any given week. They also have a hot lunch program that feeds about 100 to 150 people everyday.

This is a good way for the seniors to be able to socially interact with other seniors and to have a healthy meal at the same time. Also, the senior center has a King and Queen each year that represents their facility throughout the community. If you weren't at the program you missed a great presentation by Queen Doris who was very entertaining. Thanks for the great fun program and for all the good work that they do. It was fun learning about this center and the people that are helped with the Senior Activity Center.
