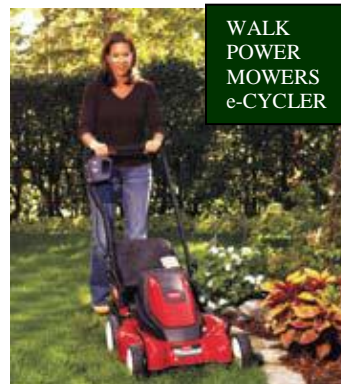


Board Meeting
