Would like to thank Joe for coming to our club and giving us the information for our continued success as Lions for us and our community.

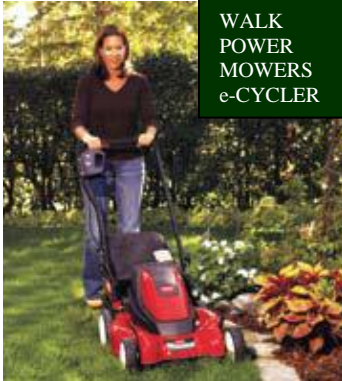
